## TRAVEL DETAILS

By plane: Rotterdam The Hague Airport is only 10km away. A Shuttle Bus will take you to the nearest metro station (Meijersplein). Take the metro to Rotterdam Central Station and take the train to Delft Campus. Renting a car is also an option.

Amsterdam Airport Schiphol is 50km away. From the airport you can take a train to Delft Zuid. Renting a car is also an option.

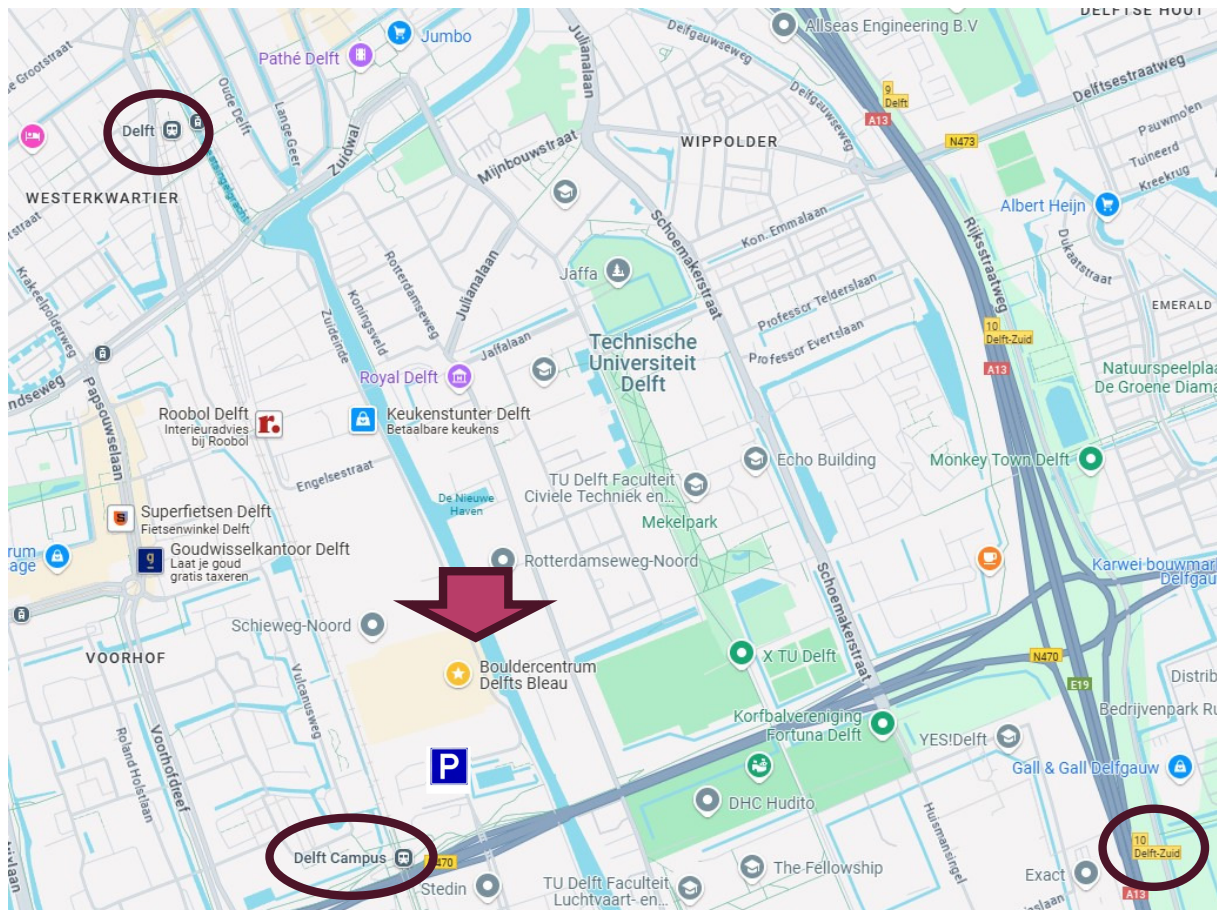
By train: Use station Delft Campus. A brief walk (5 minutes) will bring you to Bouldercentrum Delfts Bleau. If you use Delft Central Station the walk will be 15 minutes.
